Variable frequency drives (VFDs) are a crucial component in industrial automation, providing precise control over a motor's speed and torque. Any and all events that could cause a jump in DC bus voltage could lead to a dc link. When the motor's inertial feedback energy or power surge impacts the DC bus in the VFD system, if the voltage exceeds the safe range (typically $>800V/480V$ system), the DC bus overvoltage protection is triggered.
