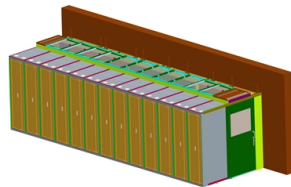


24-core and 48-core optical cables



Article Overview

24-core and 48-core fiber optic cables differ primarily in capacity, with 48-core cables supporting more connections and future expansion, but not inherently improving signal performance.

Core Count and Capacity

The core count of a fiber optic cable indicates the number of individual optical fibers it contains. A 24-core cable has 24 fibers, while a 48-core cable has 48 fibers. Higher core counts increase the distribution capacity of a network, allowing more terminations, connections, or splitters in a single cable, which is particularly useful for backbone or high-density deployments. However, core count does not affect signal quality; it only provides additional capacity for current or future network expansion.

Types of Cables

- **ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) Cables:** These are aerial cables designed for installation along power lines or poles without metallic support. They are non-metallic, self-supporting, and suitable for spans of 100–1200 meters depending on design. Both 24-core and 48-core ADSS cables are available, typically using single-mode fibers like G.652D or G.657A1.
- **Loose Tube or Gel-Filled Cables:** Fibers are protected in tubes with gel or dry fillers, suitable for outdoor or long-distance installations.
- **Indoor/Outdoor Cables:** Can be armored or non-armored depending on environmental protection needs
