Each strand is typically terminated with LC connectors, which are compact and widely compatible with SFP or SFP+ transceiver modules.

Compatibility with Switches

When connecting switches, you need SFP or SFP+ transceivers that match the fiber type (single-mode or multimode) and the network speed (1G, 10G, or higher). The transceivers rely on the two fiber strands: one port transmits while the other receives. It is important to cross-connect the fibers between the switches (A to B, B to A) to ensure proper signal flow.
