These trays are tested according to standards like DIN 4102-12, which subjects the entire cable tray system—including cables and accessories—to high temperatures (up to 1000°C) for durations of 30, 60, or 90 minutes, resulting in fire resistance grades such as E30, E60, or E90. The testing ensures that the tray can withstand fire long enough to support emergency operations. Lighting cable trays, on the other hand, are typically designed for routing and supporting electrical wiring for lighting circuits under normal conditions. Unless they are explicitly manufactured as fire-resistant or fireproof trays, they do not provide the same level of protection or maintain circuit integrity during a fire. Standard trays may be made of materials that are flammable or fail structurally under high heat, which means they cannot be relied upon for emergency lighting or other critical systems during a fire.
