

Are there green wires in the distribution box

Green wires in a distribution box are primarily used as protective ground (earth) conductors to ensure electrical safety.

Purpose of Green Wires

In electrical distribution systems, green wires (or green with yellow stripes) are designated for protective grounding. Their main function is to provide a low-resistance path to the earth, which helps prevent electric shock in case of a fault, such as a short circuit or insulation failure. By connecting exposed metal parts of appliances and electrical panels to ground, the green wire ensures that any stray voltage is safely dissipated, reducing the risk of injury or fire .

Color Coding Standards

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) and similar international standards (IEC), the color green, bare copper, or green/yellow striped wire is reserved exclusively for grounding purposes. Other colors are used for live (hot) or neutral wires, but green is universally recognized as the safety ground . In three-phase systems, the protective earth (PE) wire is typically green/yellow, while neutral is light blue and phase wires may be red, yellow, or green depending on local standards .
