They feature a robust outer jacket, often armored with steel or other protective materials, to resist soil pressure, sharp rocks, and rodent damage. Many buried cables include water-blocking gel or tape to prevent moisture intrusion and maintain signal integrity .

 - Reliable performance: Underground placement protects cables from wind, ice, and physical damage, making them up to ten times more reliable than aerial routes in harsh weather .
