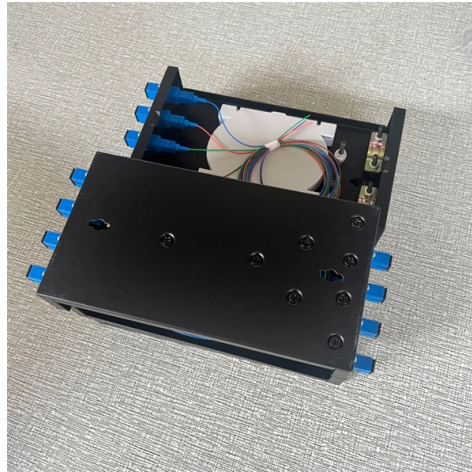


Cable Laying in Low Voltage Cable Trays



Article Overview

Proper low-voltage cable installation in trays requires correct tray sizing, spacing, fill limits, and adherence to standards to ensure safety, performance, and maintainability.

Tray Selection and Sizing

When laying low-voltage cables, choose a tray width that accommodates current and future cable counts. Use the cable's outside diameter to calculate the required tray area, applying a working fill of 40–50% to allow room for future expansion and easier maintenance. Ladder trays are preferred for backbone routes because they provide better access and airflow, reducing heat buildup and simplifying cable management. Consider route length and support spacing to prevent sagging and mechanical stress on cables.

Cable Spacing and Support

Maintain regular spacing of cables within the tray to prevent overheating and mechanical damage. Cables should be secured at intervals according to design standards, typically every 1–2 meters, depending on cable type and tray design. For ladder or ventilated trays, rung spacing of 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) is recommended to support instrumentation and control cables. Avoid excessive bending; respect the minimum bend radius specified by the cable manufacturer.
