

Cameroon Railway Optical Cable Construction



Article Overview

The Cameroon Railway Optical Cable Project involves deploying fiber optic cables along the national railway network to enhance digital connectivity and support economic development.

Overview of the Project

The project is a collaboration between Camtel, Cameroon's national telecom operator, and Camrail, the operator of the national railway network. It aims to leverage the railway corridors to lay terrestrial fiber optic cables, extending high-speed internet access to urban and rural areas along the railway lines . This approach combines transportation and digital infrastructure, optimizing existing railway rights-of-way for telecommunications deployment.

Camrail and Railway Infrastructure

Camrail, a subsidiary of Africa Global Logistics, has operated Cameroon's railway network since 1999 under a public-private partnership . The network connects major cities such as Douala, Yaoundé, Nkongsamba, Eseka, Mbanga, and Kumba, and historically aimed to link Douala to N'Djamena through the Transcamerounais project . The railway has undergone track renewal, rehabilitation, and rolling stock upgrades, particularly on the Douala-Yaoundé line, which is a key corridor for both passenger and freight transport
