A fiber optic box, or termination box, connects to fiber optic cables by securing, splicing, and managing the fibers to provide a protected interface for network distribution.

Purpose of a Fiber Termination Box

A Fiber Termination Box (FTB), also called an Optical Termination Box (OTB), is a compact enclosure designed to organize, terminate, splice, and protect fiber optic cables. It acts as a junction point between incoming feeder cables and outgoing pigtails or patch cords that connect to end-user devices or distribution frames . The box ensures that fibers are safely managed, prevents signal loss, and allows for rerouting or expansion of the network .

Components and Structure

Most FTBs consist of three main elements:

- **Housing:** The outer casing protects internal components from physical damage, dust, water, and environmental factors. Outdoor boxes often have IP65 or IP68 ratings and may include locks for security .
- **Internal Components:** These include splicing trays, cassettes, or holders that secure fibers after fusion splicing and allow for organized routing.
- **Fiber Protection Elements:** These prevent bending, kinking, or stress on the fibers,...
