While stranded wire is more flexible and better suited for applications involving movement or vibration, it can be harder to secure in terminal blocks and may require ferrules or additional preparation to ensure a reliable connection . In contrast, solid wire is easier to insert and tighten in distribution box terminals, providing a safer an...
