

Can fiber optic cables and electrical cables be placed in the same conduit



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables generally should not share a conduit with electrical cables, except in specific cases with nonconductive fiber and proper regulatory compliance.

Key Considerations

Electromagnetic Interference (EMI): While fiber optic cables themselves are immune to EMI, the components at either end (transceivers, connectors) can be affected by nearby electrical cables, potentially degrading signal quality . **Heat and Physical Damage:** Electrical cables generate heat, which can reduce the lifespan of fiber optics. Additionally, running both types in the same conduit increases the risk of crushing or bending the fiber cables . **Regulatory Compliance:** Building codes and standards, such as the National Electrical Code (NEC), have specific rules for co-locating fiber and electrical cables. Nonconductive fiber optic cables can occupy the same conduit or cable tray as electrical conductors operating at 1000 volts or less, while conductive (armored) fiber cables are not permitted in the same conduit due to fire and safety risks .

Best Practices

- **Separate Conduits:** The safest approach is to run fiber optic and electrical cables in separate conduits to avoid interference, heat, and physical damage .
- **Conduit Dividers:** If space constraints require sharing a conduit, using dividers can provide a physical barrier between fiber and electrical cables
