

Can finished pigtails be fused together

How Pigtails Are Spliced

A fiber optic pigtail has a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The bare end is designed to be permanently joined to another fiber, which can be a trunk cable or another pigtail. Fusion splicing is the most common method, where a precision electric arc melts the glass ends of the fibers together, forming a seamless, low-loss joint with typical insertion loss of 0.01–0.05 dB . This method ensures minimal back reflection and high reliability, making it ideal for backbone networks and long-distance links. Mechanical splicing is an alternative that aligns the fibers in a precision sleeve with index-matching gel. While faster and requiring less expensive equipment, mechanical splices generally have higher insertion loss (0.20–0.50 dB) and are more suitable for small-scale or temporary installations .

Practical Considerations

- **Tools Required:** A fusion splicer, fiber strippers, cleaver, and cleaning supplies are essential for high-quality splicing .
- **Fiber Type Compatibility:** Ensure both pigtails are the same type (single-mode or multimode) to avoid signal degradation .
- **Length and Slack:** Ordering slightly longer pigtails provides extra fiber for corrections and reduces the risk of tension at the splice point .
- **Testing:** After splicing, the joint should be inspected for loss and defects. A proper...
