Overview

Optical fiber cold splice technology is based on the use of mechanical connectors to join two fiber-optic cables. These connectors are designed to align and join the fibers together in a precise and secure manner. Both techniques have their advantages and are suited for different applications, but understanding which method to use can greatly impact the network's. Fiber optic joints or terminations are made two ways: 1) splices which create a permanent joint between the two fibers or 2) connectors that mate two fibers to create a temporary joint and/or connect the fiber to a piece of network gear. Either joining method must have three primary characteristics. It's the process of joining two fiber optic cables using techniques such as fusion splicing and mechanical splicing, crucial for maintaining uninterrupted communication networks. Both methods provide much lower insertion loss compared to fiber connectors.
