

Can power and low-voltage cables for surveillance systems be shared in the same cable tray



Overview

The NEC permits power and signal cables in the same tray under specific conditions. Power cables rated 600V or less and Class 2 or Class 3 signal cables may share a tray if separated by a fixed barrier or if the power cables are separated from the signal. Maintaining proper separation between power, data, and limited energy cabling is foundational to system performance, safety, and code compliance. Separation isn't just an EMI precaution — it protects signaling, reduces rework, and ensures pathways meet inspection expectations across risers. Separation of Band I low voltage cables and Band II high voltage cables is mandatory to stop electrical interference. It's inadvisable to run data cable parallel to high voltage cable but practically speaking it won't matter in your application, as long as you follow other best practices for running data cabling (only use high. Cable tray types, fill rules for single-conductor and multiconductor cables, ampacity derating, separation requirements, and when to use tray vs conduit. This practice is mandatory for two distinct reasons: ensuring the safety of the structure and its occupants, and preserving the integrity of sensitive data. While all data cable is ran within cable tray, about 20% or so of the fire alarm cable is sharing the same tray.
