Can a Beam Splitter Be Replaced?

Beam splitters are optical devices that divide a light beam into transmitted and reflected components and are used in interferometers, FTIR spectrometers, and other optical systems . In many instruments, such as research-grade FTIRs, the beam splitter is removable and replaceable without replacing the entire interferometer module . However, in some models, particularly older or compact FTIRs, the beam splitter may be integrated, requiring replacement of the entire interferometer if damaged . Replacement is also necessary if the beam splitter is damaged by moisture, scratches, or contamination .

Preparation and Safety

- Ensure the instrument is powered off to avoid exposure to lasers, especially Class 2M lasers in FTIRs .
- Maintain an environment with humidity below 60%, as high humidity can damage sensitive optics like KBr beam splitters .
- Use a desiccator to store removed beam splitters, with fresh silica gel to prevent moisture damage
