A cable can be used as a pigtail if it has a connector on one end and a bare or stripped end for splicing or connecting to another wire or device.

What a Pigtail Is

A pigtail is a short length of wire, cable, or optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare, stripped, or unterminated end on the other. This design allows the difficult part of termination—attaching the connector—to be done in a controlled environment, while the open end can be spliced, soldered, crimped, or fused to another conductor or fiber in the field . Pigtails are commonly used in both electrical wiring and fiber optic networks.

Electrical Pigtails

In electrical applications, a pigtail is typically 6 to 8 inches long and connects multiple wires to a single device terminal, such as an outlet, switch, or fixture. The bare end is spliced to the circuit wiring using a wire nut or push-in connector, while the connector end attaches to the device. This method prevents overcrowding at terminals and ensures a secure, reliable connection .

Fiber Optic Pigtails

For fiber optics, a pigtail has a factory-installed connector on one end and bare fiber on the other. The bare fiber is fusion-spliced or mechanically spliced to the field fiber, allowing fast, reliable terminations at patch panels, ODFs, or terminal boxes. Unlike...
