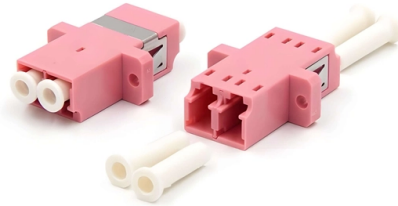
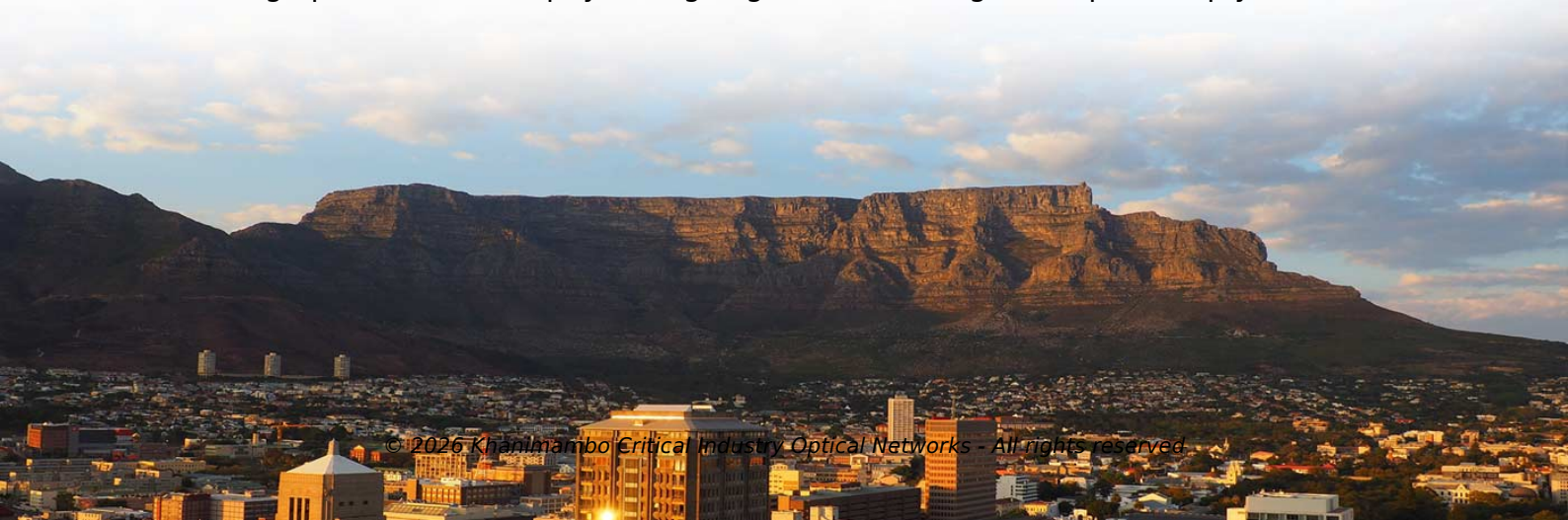


Canadian voltage anomaly
