

Composition and Structure of Optical Cable



Article Overview

Optical cables are composed of a core, cladding, coating, strength members, and an outer jacket, designed to transmit light signals efficiently while protecting the fiber from mechanical and environmental damage.

Core

The core is the central part of the optical fiber that carries light signals. It is typically made of ultra-pure silica glass (SiO_2), sometimes doped with materials like germanium to adjust the refractive index for optimal light propagation. The core diameter varies depending on the fiber type: single-mode fibers usually have a core of 8–10 μm , while multimode fibers range from 50 μm to 62.5 μm . Light travels through the core via total internal reflection, which occurs because the core has a higher refractive index than the surrounding cladding.

Cladding

Surrounding the core is the cladding, which has a slightly lower refractive index than the core. This difference ensures that light remains confined within the core, minimizing signal loss. Cladding is often made from silica glass and may be fused to the core during manufacturing. Standard cladding diameters are typically 125 μm or 140 μm , depending on the fiber design.
