To connect a fiber optic module to a pigtail, you typically use a fusion or mechanical splice to join the bare fiber end of the pigtail to the incoming fiber, while the pre-terminated connector plugs into the module.

The connector end plugs directly into a fiber optic module, patch panel, or active equipment, while the bare fiber end is designed for permanent splicing to the incoming fiber. This ensures low signal loss and reliable connectivity .

- Fusion splicer or mechanical splicing kit
- Fiber cleaver for precise cutting
- Fiber stripper to remove the protective coating
- Isopropyl alcohol wipes for cleaning
- Protective sleeves for spliced fibers
