

Connect two fiber optic cold connectors

Fiber optic cold connectors can be connected using mechanical splicing or quick-connect connector methods, both providing low-loss, non-fusion connections.

1. Mechanical Splicing

Mechanical splicing, also known as cold splicing, aligns two fiber ends in a precision sleeve or V-groove without using heat. The process involves:

- Preparing the fiber ends: Strip the protective coating, clean the fibers, and cleave them to a precise length.
- Inserting the fibers: Place each fiber end into a mechanical splice holder or V-groove, ensuring proper alignment.
- Securing the splice: Tighten the splice using a clamp or specialized tool to hold the fibers in place.
- Index matching: Apply an index-matching gel to reduce light reflection and insertion loss.
- Testing: Inspect the splice for alignment and measure insertion loss to ensure proper performance. Mechanical splicing is quick, cost-effective, and flexible, suitable for temporary connections or field installations where fusion splicing equipment is unavailable. Typical insertion loss ranges from 0.1 to 0.3 dB, and the connection can be easily disconnected if needed.
