Standard optical fiber cables contain no copper, but hybrid fiber-copper cables integrate copper for power, grounding, or cable tracing purposes.

Standard Fiber Optic Cables

Pure fiber optic cables are designed to transmit data using light signals through glass or plastic fibers, not electrical currents. Their main components include a core (ultra-thin glass or plastic fiber), cladding (reflective layer to keep light in the core), buffer coating (protective polymer), and an outer jacket (PVC or polyethylene for mechanical protection). These cables do not contain metallic copper, which allows them to be immune to electromagnetic interference, electrical hazards, and ground loops, while supporting extremely high data rates over long distances.

Hybrid Fiber-Copper Cables

Some fiber optic cables incorporate copper conductors alongside the optical fibers. These hybrid designs are used when additional functionality is required, such as:

- Power delivery to remote devices like wireless access points or IP cameras
 - Grounding or bonding for safety and environmental resilience
 - Cable locating and tracing in complex installations
- In these cases, the copper does not carry data; the optical fibers handle all data transmission, while the copper provides direct current (DC) power or grounding paths. Typical applications include cellular networks, distributed antenna systems, and surveillance systems, where combining power and data in a single cable simplifies installation and reduces infra...
