A core switch with Layer 3 support provides high-speed routing, VLAN interconnectivity, and redundancy at the backbone of an enterprise network.

Overview of Core Switches

A core switch is positioned at the top of a hierarchical network, serving as the backbone that interconnects distribution or aggregation switches and ensures high-speed data transfer across the network. Unlike access or distribution switches, core switches are optimized for Layer 3 (L3) routing, enabling them to route traffic between VLANs, subnets, and security zones efficiently. They are designed for high throughput, low latency, and fault tolerance, often supporting port speeds from 10G to 400G+ and wire-speed forwarding.

Layer 3 Capabilities

Layer 3 support allows core switches to perform IP routing functions in addition to traditional MAC-based switching. Key L3 features include:

- **Inter-VLAN Routing:** Enables communication between different VLANs without requiring an external router.
- **Advanced Routing Protocols:** Supports OSPF, EIGRP, BGP, and static routing for scalable network design.
- **Redundancy Protocols:** Implements HSRP or VRRP to provide high availability, allowing a secondary core switch to take over instantly if the primary fails.
- **Traffic Summarization:** L3 links between core switches allow network summarization...
