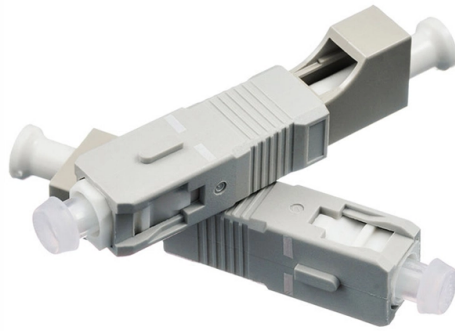


Correct insertion and removal of the PON pigtail cable



Overview

Make a small incision with 11-blade alongside guidewire, then dilate to required depth with dilator, then insert pigtail with obturator over wire to appropriate depth. Drill (4) holes in the wall based on the drill template and place an expansion bolt in each hole, align the enclosure to holes and use the bolt to fasten the enclosure to the wall. Route the drop cables through the attachment hardware on the bottom right hand side of the base. It is recommended that we discontinue stocking larger sized chest tubes (32Fr, 36Fr) and Cook 9Fr pneumothorax set with metal trochar/needle. Pediatrics: PALS carts should be stocked. Crimp speaker wire terminals by stripping 10–12 mm of insulation, twisting strands tightly, inserting them fully into the barrel, and using the crimp tool size matched to the terminal's rated wire range. Apply steady force until the tool releases. Inspect for a clean copper wrap and no stray.
