Physical Hazards

Handling fiber optic cables during T-splitting can expose technicians to microscopic glass shards, which can cause cuts or splinters if fibers break or are improperly handled . Additionally, exposure to laser light from live fibers can damage the retina, especially if high-powered lasers are involved, though typical visual fault locators are generally safe . Proper personal protective equipment (PPE), such as safety glasses and gloves, is essential to prevent injury.

Signal Integrity Risks

T-splitting a fiber optic cable introduces signal attenuation because the optical power is divided between multiple paths. Even minor imperfections in the split can cause:

- Insertion loss, reducing the effective transmission distance and bandwidth .
- Modal dispersion, leading to data errors or dropped connections .
- Complete signal failure if the split is poorly executed or the fiber is damaged . For example, a small nick in a single-mode fiber can significantly reduce its effective range, potentially disrupting critical services like telemedicine or financial networks .
