The core's diameter varies: single-mode fibers usually have a 9-micron core, while multi-mode fibers range from 50 to 62.5 microns. The core enables total internal reflection, allowing light to propagate over long distances with minimal loss.

### Cladding

Surrounding the core is the cladding, which has a slightly lower refractive index than the core. This difference ensures that light remains confined within the core through total internal reflection. The cladding is usually made of glass or plastic and is essential for maintaining signal integrity over long distances.

### Coating (Buffer)

The coating or buffer layer protects the core and cladding from physical damage, moisture, and microbending. It is typically made of acrylate or other cushioning mat...
