

Distance between electrical wiring in distribution box and operating surface



Overview

You're not if you fail to comply with the following three clearance requirements in Sec. -wide working space in front of equipment operating at 600V or less; and. As a licensed electrician, ensuring proper nec working clearance around electrical equipment is not just a matter of compliance—it's a fundamental requirement for safety and serviceability. Equipment that may need examination, adjustment, servicing, or maintenance while energized. Electrical clearances set the minimum safe distances for panels, overhead lines, pools, and buried wiring — and ignoring them has real consequences. NEC Article 408 covers switchboards, switchgear, and Panelboards installation and applications. To re-cap Article #1 from March 5th and as required by OSHA, NFPA and the NEC: "working space around electrical enclosures or equipment shall be adequate for conducting all anticipated maintenance and operations safely, including sufficient space to ensure the safety of personnel working during.
