Article Overview

Proper lightning protection and grounding of distribution boxes ensure safety, prevent equipment damage, and maintain system reliability.

Key Principles

Lightning protection for distribution boxes involves both external and internal measures. External protection includes air-termination devices or lightning rods that intercept strikes, while internal protection uses surge protective devices (SPDs) to limit voltage surges entering the box. Grounding is essential to safely dissipate lightning energy into the earth and prevent dangerous potential differences.

Grounding Techniques

- **Combined Grounding System:** Connect the distribution box's grounding to the building's main grounding grid. This ensures that protective ground, functional ground, and enclosure ground share a common reference, reducing the risk of voltage differences during a lightning strike.
- **Electrode Design:** For standalone cabinets, use vertical copper-plated steel electrodes connected with a grounding bar. Typically, five vertical electrodes spaced around the box provide effective grounding in soils with resistivity around 150 Ohm·m.
- **Equipotential Bonding:** All metallic parts of the distribution box, including covers, panels, and internal racks, should be bonded to the grounding system. This prevents sparks and fire hazards by equalizing potential across all conductive surfaces
