How Optical Splitters Work

A fiber optic splitter is a passive device that divides a single incoming optical signal into multiple output signals without altering the data itself. For example, a 1×32 splitter can take one fiber from the central office and split it into 32 fibers, each going to a different home or device. The splitter does not assign IP addresses; it only distributes the optical signal physically.

IP Address Assignment in PON Networks

In a Passive Optical Network (PON), each output fiber from the splitter is connected to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) at the customer's location. Each ONT functions as a separate network endpoint and communicates with the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the central office. The OLT or the network's DHCP server assigns a unique IP address to each ONT, ensuring that each subscriber or device can be individually identified on the network.
