Aggregation switches can function as gateways if configured for Layer 3 routing, but not all aggregation switches inherently serve as gateways.

Role of an Aggregation Switch

An aggregation switch consolidates traffic from multiple access switches, wireless access points, or other edge devices and forwards it to core switches or routers, effectively acting as a bridge between the access and core layers of a network . These switches are designed to handle high-bandwidth traffic, reduce bottlenecks, and improve network scalability and reliability .

Gateway Functionality

Whether an aggregation switch acts as a gateway depends on its configuration and capabilities:

- **Layer 2 Aggregation Switches:** These switches primarily forward traffic based on MAC addresses and do not perform IP routing. They rely on upstream routers or Layer 3 core switches to serve as the network gateway .
- **Layer 3 Aggregation Switches:** These switches can perform routing functions, including IP address translation, VLAN routing, and DHCP services. In such cases, they can act as a gateway for wired and wireless users, managing routing and forwarding of user traffic directly . For example, in some enterprise deployments, aggregation...
