

Does fiber optic cable jumping to Africa have positive and negative poles



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables do not have positive or negative electrical poles; they transmit data as light signals, and polarity refers to the alignment of transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) channels, not electrical charge.

How Fiber Optic Cables Work

Fiber optic cables carry information using pulses of light rather than electrical current. Unlike copper cables, which rely on voltage differences between positive and negative poles to transmit electricity, fiber optics use light signals to encode and transmit data over long distances. This means there are no positive or negative electrical poles in a fiber optic cable, including those connecting Africa via submarine or terrestrial networks .

Understanding Fiber Polarity

In fiber optic systems, polarity refers to the correct alignment of the transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) ports between devices. For a fiber link to function properly, the Tx port on one end must connect to the Rx port on the other end, and vice versa. This ensures that data flows correctly in both directions. Polarity is maintained using specific patch cord configurations, such as A-B (crossover) or A-A (straight-through) duplex cords, and through keyed connectors that prevent misalignment .
