

# Does the aggregation switch need configuration

Without configuration, the switch cannot effectively balance traffic, provide failover, or prevent misconfigurations.

### Types of Link Aggregation

- Static Link Aggregation (Manual Configuration): Requires manual setup on both ends of the link. All ports in the aggregation group must have consistent settings, including speed, duplex mode, VLAN configuration, and STP parameters. Static aggregation does not provide automatic failover, so careful configuration is critical.
- Dynamic Link Aggregation (LACP): Uses the Link Aggregation Control Protocol to automatically negotiate and maintain the aggregation group. LACP ensures both en...
