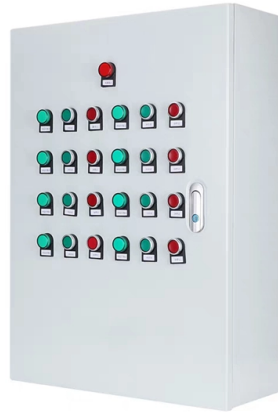


Does the router differentiate between fiber optic and fiber optic routes
