Fiber optic cable baffles are typically made from FRP (fiberglass reinforced plastic) or dielectric materials, often specified according to industry standards like TS EN 60794.

Purpose of Baffles in Fiber Optic Cables

Baffles in fiber optic cables serve as internal separators or protective barriers that prevent optical fibers from moving excessively, reduce microbending, and maintain the cable's structural integrity during installation and operation. They also help distribute mechanical stress evenly across the fibers and protect them from crush, tension, or environmental factors .

Common Materials for Baffles

- FRP (Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic):
 - Widely used as a rigid, non-metallic baffle inside the cable core.
 - Provides high tensile strength and stability while remaining lightweight.
 - Often used in both indoor and outdoor cables, including armored and non-metallic designs .
- Dielectric Yarns or Tubes:
 - Materials like aramid fibers (Kevlar®) or glass yarns are used for flexible baffles or buffer tube reinforcement.
 - These materials are non-conductive, lightweight, and provide excellent tensile and crush resistance .
