It also helps in managing tension during manufacturing and ensures that the fibers remain properly aligned within the cable jacket .

Materials Used

- Aramid fibers: Commonly used due to their high tensile strength, low elongation, and temperature stability. Aramid binder yarns also contribute to water-blocking capabilities when combined with proprietary treatments, reducing moisture penetration and protecting the fibers .
- Other binder yarns: Can include polyester or other synthetic fibers, chosen for flexibility, strength, and compatibility with the cable's intended environment .

Binding Process

The binding process involves wrapping the binder yarn around the fiber core at controlled tension. High-speed binding requires precise machinery to maintain low...
