

Fiber Optic Cable Terminal Suspension Line Installation



Article Overview

Fiber optic terminal suspension lines must be installed with proper pole attachment, minimum clearances, tension control, and protective handling to ensure safety and cable integrity.

Pole Attachment and Anchoring

- Use approved anchors only: Attach suspension lines to existing anchors only with permission from the anchor owner; do not attach to communication anchors or add auxiliary eye attachments without approval ().
- New anchor locations: Must be specified on construction prints or approved by the network authority ().
- Strand attachment height: Follow construction drawings; typically, a minimum of 18 feet clearance above traveled roads is required ().
- Clearance from energized conductors: Maintain at least 40 inches from any energized conductor, neutral, or utility pole power as specified in construction drawings ().

Cable Handling and Installation

- Minimize bending and twisting: Fiber optic cables should be bent as little as possible; avoid sharp turns, edges, and excessive tension ().
- Use protective materials: Keep protective coverings on reels until installation; reseal cable ends to prevent moisture intrusion ()....
