

Fiber Optic Cable Trench



Article Overview

Fiber optic cable trenching involves excavating trenches to lay conduits or ducts for underground fiber, with methods ranging from traditional deep trenching to shallow microtrenching for urban environments.

Traditional Trenching

Traditional trenching involves digging an open trench to a depth typically around 1-1.65 meters (3-5 feet) depending on local regulations and environmental conditions . The trench is used to lay HDPE or PVC ducts, which house the fiber optic cables. In some cases, additional protective pipes such as RCC or GI pipes are installed over the ducts to prevent damage . Trenches are usually placed along road boundaries, away from high-traffic areas, and require permissions from road and rail authorities to avoid future disruptions . After laying the ducts, the trench is backfilled, and optical tests are performed to ensure proper installation .

Microtrenching

Microtrenching is a shallow, narrow trenching method widely used in urban areas to minimize surface disruption . Typical dimensions are 0.75-2.25 inches wide and 8-17 inches deep (20-43 cm) . A vacuum system removes debris during cutting, and the conduit or fiber cable is placed directly into the trench, which is then backfilled with a grout or cement-like compound . Microtrenching allows rapid deployment, with crews able to install over a mile of fiber in a day in residential FTTH projects, significantly faster than traditional methods like horizontal directional drilling
