- **Strip the Outer Jacket Carefully** Use a precision fiber optic stripper to remove the outer jacket and buffer tube. Avoid using utility knives, which can nick the fibers and compromise performance . Work in a clean, well-lit area to prevent contamination.
- **Separate Individual Fibers** Once the jacket is removed, gently untwist the fiber strands. For multi-fiber cables, maintain the natural twist as much as possible to avoid stress on the fibers. Use fiber holders or splicing trays to keep fibers organized and prevent tangling .
- **Clean and Inspect Fibers** After untwisting, clean each fiber with isopropyl alcohol (IPA) and lint-free wipes to remove any debris or oils. Inspect the fiber ends under a microscope to ensure there are no scratches or cracks before cleaving or splicing .
- **Minimize Fiber Stress** Avoid bending fibers beyond their minimum bend radius. Untwisting should be done slowly and methodically, keeping fibers straight and sup...

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
