A dual ring consists of two parallel rings, often used in SONET/SDH networks. One ring serves as the primary path while the second provides redundancy. If the primary ring fails, traffic is rerouted to the secondary ring, ensuring minimal downtime. Dual rings are widely used in telecommunications and mission-critical systems .

### Self-Healing Ring

A self-healing ring automatically reroutes traffic in case of a failure using protocols like Automatic Protection Switching (APS). This ensures continuous operation with minimal disruption, making it ideal for industrial automation, smart grids, and surveillance systems ....
