Overview of Fiber Optic Cables

Fiber optic cables are designed to transmit data at high speeds using light signals. They are primarily categorized into single-mode and multi-mode fibers. Single-mode fibers have a small core (8-10 microns) for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications, while multi-mode fibers have a larger core (50-62.5 microns) suitable for short-range, high-speed connections. Fiber cables can be designed for indoor, outdoor, or industrial environments, with options like tight-buffered or loose-tube constructions.

Armored vs Non-Armored Fiber Optic Cables

Armored fiber optic cables include an additional protective layer, typically made of steel or aluminum, surrounding the fiber core. This armor protects against crushing, rodent damage, moisture, and impact stress, making them ideal for outdoor, exposed, or harsh environments such as poles, trenches, or industrial floors. Non-armored fiber optic cables rely on their outer jacket and internal structure for protection. They are lighter, more flexible, and easier to install, making them suitable for indoor use, ducts, or protected conduits where mechanical stress is minimal
