

Fiber optic cable is normal with no signal

A fiber optic cable showing no signal is usually caused by physical damage, dirty connectors, faulty transceivers, or equipment misconfigurations, and can be resolved through systematic inspection, cleaning, and testing.

Step 1: Inspect Physical Connections

Check all fiber cables for visible damage such as cuts, kinks, sharp bends, or crushed sections, as these can interrupt signal transmission . Ensure connectors are fully seated and properly aligned. Verify that the correct fiber type (single-mode or multimode) is used consistently across the link .

Step 2: Clean Connectors and End Faces

Contamination on connectors or end faces is a common cause of signal loss. Use a fiber inspection microscope to examine the end faces for dust, oil, or scratches . Clean connectors using lint-free wipes with isopropyl alcohol or a one-click fiber cleaner, following IEC 61300-3-35 standards . Always clean both ends of the connection and avoid touching the end face with fingers.

Step 3: Test Signal Strength

Use an optical power meter or an Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to measure signal levels and locate breaks or high-attenuation points . Signal readings outside the expected range (typically -15 dBm to -30 dBm) indicate a problem. OTDR testing is especially useful for long-haul or hidden fiber runs....
