The bare end is fusion-spliced to a trunk or distribution cable inside a splice tray or fiber distribution box. Common types include single-mode OS2, multimode OM3/OM4. Fiber termination refers to the process of preparing the end of a fiber optic cable to connect to another fiber, a device, or a network. Done right, it produces connections with less than 0.
