Fiber optic ports on a Layer 3 switch enable high-speed, long-distance data transmission while supporting routing between VLANs and networks.

Overview of Layer 3 Switches

A Layer 3 switch operates at the network layer (Layer 3) of the OSI model, combining traditional switching with routing capabilities. Unlike Layer 2 switches that forward traffic based on MAC addresses, Layer 3 switches can route packets between VLANs or subnets using IP addresses, reducing latency and eliminating the need for an external router . Fiber optic ports enhance these switches by providing higher bandwidth, faster speeds, and longer transmission distances compared to copper Ethernet connections .

Types of Fiber Optic Ports

- SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) Ports
 - Hot-pluggable modules that support fiber or copper connections.
 - Can handle speeds from 1G to 10G depending on the module.
 - Compatible with single-mode fiber for long distances or multi-mode fiber for shorter distances.
 - Typically use LC-type connectors for fiber connections .
- SFP+ Ports
 - Enhanced version of SFP, supporting 10G speeds.
 - Often used for uplinks to core switches or high-performance servers
