Fault Detection and Isolation

Protective relays continuously monitor electrical quantities such as current, voltage, frequency, and phase angle to detect abnormal conditions like overcurrent, short circuits, earth faults, or voltage imbalances. When a fault is detected, the relay sends a trip signal to the circuit breaker, isolating the faulty section from the rest of the system to prevent further damage and maintain operational continuity.

Relays are designed to operate selectively, ensuring that only the circuit closest to the fault is disconnected while the rest of the system continues functioning. This selective operation minimizes disruption and prevents cascading failures. They also operate rapidly, reducing the risk of equipment damage and voltage instability caused by prolonged fault currents.
