

Gigabit optical port transmission rate of the switch

A standard Gigabit optical (SFP) port on a switch supports 1 Gbps data transmission, with SFP+ ports capable of 10 Gbps.

Standard Speed

A Gigabit optical port, typically implemented as an SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) slot, is designed to handle 1 Gbps (1000 Mbps) Ethernet traffic over fiber optic cables or copper, depending on the module used . This speed aligns with the Gigabit Ethernet standard, which transmits data at 1 gigabit per second, significantly faster than Fast Ethernet (100 Mbps) and suitable for high-performance local area networks .

SFP vs SFP+ Ports

- SFP (1G): Supports standard Gigabit Ethernet speeds (1 Gbps) and can use either single-mode or multi-mode fiber for distances ranging from hundreds of meters to tens of kilometers . Copper SFP modules allow 1 Gbps over Cat5e/Cat6 cabling.
- SFP+ (10G): Designed for 10 Gbps speeds, backward compatible with standard SFP modules in some switches, and typically used for uplinks or high-bandwidth connections .
