

Grounding Standards for Optical Cable Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Optical cable distribution boxes must have metallic components bonded and grounded to ensure safety, prevent equipment damage, and mitigate electromagnetic interference, especially when metallic elements are present or the cable is near power conductors.

Key Grounding Principles

1. **Metallic Components:** Even though optical fiber itself is dielectric, any metallic members such as steel armor, strength members, or tracer wires must be grounded and bonded. This protects against voltage transients, lightning strikes, and electrostatic buildup, which could otherwise damage equipment or create safety hazards (Corning AEN 140, FOA standards) . 2. **Point of Grounding:**

- For cables entering a building, metallic members should be grounded as close as practicable to the point of entrance.
- For cables terminating outside a building, grounding should occur near the termination point.

• If an insulating joint or equivalent device is used, grounding may not be required even when exposed to power conductors (NEC 770.93 A & B) . 3. **Bonding Infrastructure:**

- A Primary Bonding Busbar (PBB) should be installed in the telecommunications entrance room or space.
- All cables and equipment, including distribution boxes, should be bonded to the P...
