Overview

Equipment Protection: Grounding protects substation equipment from potential damage from lightning strikes, fault currents, and transient overvoltages. The longevity and dependability of essential electrical components are both preserved with the assistance of this protection. Safety of Personnel: By safely channeling fault currents into the ground, proper grounding helps to reduce the risk of electric shock to personnel. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. Any engineer dealing with power supply networks needs to understand the basic. How should we protect ourselves from the safety issue?

For example, for High And Low Voltage Distribution Cabinets, the distribution box needs to be grounded regardless of size.
