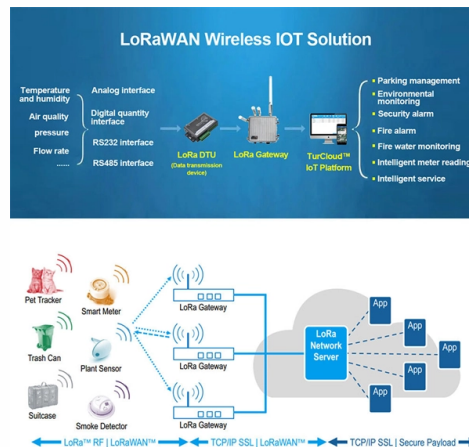


Grounding requirements for distribution box enclosures



Article Overview

Distribution box enclosures must be properly grounded using dedicated conductors, bonding points, and low-resistance connections to ensure safety and NEC compliance.

Key Grounding Principles

Metallic enclosures must be bonded to the building grounding system to prevent electrical shock and ensure fault current paths. This includes the enclosure body, doors, backpanels, and any metallic components inside the box. Non-metallic enclosures generally do not require grounding unless they contain metallic frames or components.

Conductor Sizing and Connections

- US Market: Use a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire from the enclosure to the central grounding point.
- Other Markets: Use a 6 mm² ground wire.
- Feeder and Branch Circuits: Provide separate insulated green ground conductors connected from the panel ground bus to all connected equipment.
- Doors and Hinged Panels: Bond doors to the enclosure using dedicated grounding screws or flexible copper braided jumpers to maintain low contact resistance, especially for moving parts
