Understanding Relay Sensitivity

Sensitivity of a protective relay refers to its ability to operate reliably under conditions that produce the least operating tendency, meaning it can detect very small fault currents or abnormal conditions in the system . High sensitivity ensures that even minor faults are detected promptly, preventing equipment damage and maintaining system stability.

Relays with High Sensitivity

- **Directional Relays:** These relays are designed to detect the direction of fault currents and are noted for high speed and high sensitivity, capable of operating with low voltage levels and small currents . They are widely used in ring mains and interconnected networks where precise fault detection is critical.
- **Electromagnetic Relays:** Certain moving coil or polarized electromagnetic relays can achieve very high sensitivity due to lightweight contacts and precise magnetic circuits. These relays can respond to minimal current changes and operate quickly, making them suitable for applications requiring fast and sensitive fault detection .
- **Differential Relays:** While not explicitly mentioned in the web results, differential relays are inherently sensitive because they operate based on the difference between incoming and outgoing currents in a protected zone, allowing detection of even small internal faults in transformers, generators, or busbars
