

Hot melt tube for ribbon optical cable splicing

Hot melt tubes are heat-activated protective sleeves designed to secure and reinforce ribbon optical fiber splices, providing mechanical strength, environmental protection, and maintaining optical transmission performance.

Structure and Materials

Hot melt tubes for ribbon fiber splicing typically consist of three main components:

- Cross-linked polyolefin outer tube: Provides heat resistance, mechanical strength, and elongation properties, ensuring the splice is protected from environmental stress and mechanical damage .
- Hot melt inner tube: A thermoplastic polymer that melts under heat to form a tight, bubble-free seal around the fiber, rebuilding the fiber coating and maintaining optical transmission .
- Reinforcing rod: Usually made of stainless steel, quartz, or ceramic, this rod prevents warping and protects the fiber during heating, ensuring the splice remains aligned and structurally supported .

Key Features

- Mechanical Strength: The combination of the hot melt inner tube and reinforcing rod rebuilds the fiber coating at the fusion joint, providing durability and preventing breakage
