

How does a light source power meter emit light



Article Overview

A light source emits photons through energy transitions in atoms or semiconductors, while a power meter measures the emitted light by converting photons into an electrical signal.

Light Emission from a Source

Light is emitted when energy is supplied to a material, causing electrons to move to higher energy levels. When these electrons return to lower energy states, they release energy in the form of photons, which are particles of light. The energy of each photon is determined by its wavelength according to Planck's equation: $E = hc/\lambda$, where h is Planck's constant, c is the speed of light, and λ is the wavelength of the emitted light. Different light sources use different mechanisms:

- Incandescent bulbs heat a filament until it glows, emitting a broad spectrum of light.
- LEDs (Light Emitting Diodes) use semiconductors where electrons recombine with holes, releasing photons at specific wavelengths.
- Lasers produce coherent light through stimulated emission, where photons trigger the emission of additional photons of the same phase and wavelength. The total light output is quantified as luminous flux in lumens, which represents the perceived brightness to the human eye, while luminous intensity in candelas measures the directional strength of light
